




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FUND COLLECTION FOR KODUGU & KERALA FLOOD RELIEF: 25/8/2018

A Natural disaster is a major adverse event resulting from natural process of the Earth, examples are floods, hurricanes, tornadoes, volcanic eruptions, tsunamis, and other geologic processes. A natural disaster can cause loss of life or damage property, and typically leaves some economic damage in its wake, the severity of which depends on the affected population's resilience, or ability to recover and also on the infrastructure available. In the month of August 2018, Kerala state and Kodagu district in the state of Karnataka witnessed flooding due to heavy rains. Nearly 18 lives were lost in the deluge and now a detailed report on the floods reveals that this disaster was due to human activities. The finding of the report suggests that man-made activities triggered landslides in Kodagu during the floods.

NSS volunteers and students of KSIT generated fund of Rupees 37,936/ for the victims of KODUGU and KERALA and also items required the victims. This amount is submitted to the management of KSIT .The faculties of K S Group of Institutions donated one day salary for the relief. A total sum of Rs 15 lakh was donated to CM relief fund of Karnataka from KAMAVARI SANGA.

DRUG AWARENESS WALK: 10th NOV 2018

According to a survey everyday India sees 10 suicides related to drug abuse, Kids hear about drugs everywhere: on TV, radio, news, online, music and movies; and sometimes even on the street or on the playground. The teen years are the most likely time for someone to start trying drugs. And starting drug use as a teen can lead to drug problems when they grow up.

The incidence of drug abuse among children and adolescents is higher than the general population. This is notably because youth is a time for experimentation and identity forming. In India an NGO survey revealed that 63.6 % of patients coming in for treatment were introduced to drugs at a young age below 15 years. There are very few to no health centers that deal with child substance abuse problems, especially in the rural areas. The use of tobacco is another major concern among children. In India 20 million children a year and nearly 55,000 children a day are drawn into a tobacco addiction. The number is shocking when compared to the 3000 a day new child smokers in the US.

A small step towards tackling the above issue we NSS KSIT supported team Aarohan to organize a walkathon for all the college students along with our police to create awareness. Our Bangalore city police along with the entire team supported all the participants to say **NO TO DRUGS.**

DENTAL AWARENESS AND FREE SCREENING CAMP: 03/11/2018

Overview:

During the first three decades of life the primary cause of tooth loss is decay. From the middle 30s to the late 50s, periodontal (gum) disease is identified as the main reason teeth are removed. And after age 60, tooth decay is again the major cause of tooth loss. But the type and extent of tooth decay experienced by seniors is very different from that which affects children.

Decay in late life often occurs around the edges of fillings and crowns or on root surfaces of teeth that are exposed because of gum recession. This kind of tooth decay advances rapidly and is generally difficult and expensive to treat. It frequently requires a larger filling or new crown to be placed.

If the problem is isolated to the root of a tooth all that may be necessary is a filling, but this is more the exception than the rule. In some instances because the decay is so extensive the tooth may need a root canal or must be removed.

No matter what age, prevention is the key to maintaining good oral health. Knowing what particular dental problems you are at risk for developing and how you can reduce those risks will help you decide the most appropriate means to prevent dental problems.

Susceptibility to various dental problems change as people age. Each person's risk factors are unique. A thorough understanding of what they are is necessary to adequately reduce those risks.so **NSS KSIT** student branch in collaboration with IEEE KSIT conducted "**Dental Awareness Camp**" on 3rd November 2018. The main objective of this event was to provide good oral health to the fellow KSIT members.

300 students along with staff members actively participated in this event. The dentists of Partha's Dental Clinic diagnosed oral problems of the students & provided beneficiary advices to the students regarding their oral health.

NSS and IEEE volunteers served as a helping hand to the doctors by assisting them in the service. NSS KSIT sincerely thanks Partha's Dental Clinic for their support.

Side effects of drug addiction may include:


- A weakened immune system, increasing the risk of illness and infection
