#### A Report on

### 'MEGA ATV CHAMPIONSHIP 2019'

From 25th to 29th March 2020 at Querim Beach, Goa

Organized by Autosport India in association with FMSCI.

Team Redline Racing had decided to participate in the event Mega ATV Championship Season-V organized by Autosport India in association with FMSCI. This was our 2<sup>nd</sup> year participation for the event. We had successfully cleared the virtual rounds of the event which was the entry criteria for the event. Once completing the virtual round, we started upgrading the vehicle and tested it thoroughly.

As the Baja registrations were closed by the time, team was formed and also a new team was suggested to form in K S School Engineering and Management (KSSEM); permissions were taken from **Dr. K V A Balaji**, CEO, KSGI; **Dr.K. Rama Narasimha**, Principal, KSSEM; **Dr. Balaji B**, Head, Dept. of Mech. Engg., and permission from **Dr.T.V Govindaraju**, Principal, KSIT and **Prof. Umashankar M**, Head, Dept. of Mech. Engg.

As we had the vehicle ready and KSSEM campus had a ground, so we decided to give driver more practice as we could not find time for drivers practice previous year. The Mega ATV championship track is more dynamic oriented which will be vigorous than the Baja track. So to strengthen the vehicle we had install Ribs and support structures which are small in size but will impact in larger scale when applied in practically.

### **IMPROVEMENTS:**

During last year Baja race 2019 brake lines, steering rack mounts, shafts were damaged. This year we designed and fabricated a better brake disc which dissipates heat more efficiently and also got customized steel braided stronger brake lines. The new steering rack mounts and stronger butt welded shafts were used .As previous driver gear and safety equipment were expired as per rule book, So new driver gear and safety equipment and tools were brought, better hub and knuckle were designed and fabricated to withstand more stress and new graphics were designed this year. We had performed iterations on transmissions. We were able to perform 70 transmission iterations for different tracks such as acceleration, torque, suspension and so on, so the driver was very comfortable and confident about performance of the vehicle this time as compared previous year.
