## HISTORY OF KANNADA RAJYOTSAVA

Karnataka Rajyotsava, or Karnataka Formation Day, is celebrated annually on November 1 to commemorate the day in 1956 when the Kannada-speaking regions of India were unified to form the state of Karnataka. This reorganization followed the States Reorganization Act, which aimed to reorganize Indian states based on linguistic lines. Before this, Kannada-speaking areas were scattered across different provinces, including Bombay, Madras, Hyderabad, and Mysore. Mysore State, renamed Karnataka in 1973, became the home for Kannadigas, symbolizing their shared cultural, linguistic, and historical identity. The day is marked by grand celebrations, cultural events, and the hoisting of the Karnataka flag, reflecting the pride and unity of the state's people.

## SCOPE OF THE PROGRAM

The scope of Karnataka Rajyotsava extends beyond mere celebration, serving as a platform to promote the state's rich cultural, historical, and linguistic heritage.
