## **HISTORY OF ENVIRONMENT DAY**

World Environment Day was established by the United Nations General Assembly in 1972 to promote global awareness and encourage action on environmental challenges. Since 1973, it has been observed annually on June 5, with a different host country each year. The day serves as a global platform for engaging governments, organizations, and individuals in efforts to protect and preserve the environment.

The official theme for World Environment Day 2025 is “**Beat Plastic Pollution.**” This campaign aims to raise awareness about the adverse impacts of plastic waste on ecosystems, wildlife, and human health, while promoting sustainable practices to reduce plastic pollution worldwide.

## **SCOPE OF THE PROGRAM**

World Environment Day is observed to raise awareness about environmental issues and promote sustainable living. It encourages individuals and communities to take action in protecting natural resources and supporting a cleaner environment. Activities such as sapling plantation and poster-making help spread awareness and inspire collective responsibility for a greener future.

## **HIGHLIGHTS OF THE EVENT**

On May 24, 2025, the NSS unit of KS Institute of Technology (KSIT) conducted an environmental awareness program in Malligemetlu village in observance of World Environment Day.
