## **HISTORY OF INDEPENDENCE DAY:**

Indian Independence Day, observed every year on 15th August, commemorates the conclusion of almost two hundred years of British colonial domination in India. It stands as a tribute to the unwavering struggle and countless sacrifices of the freedom fighters who dedicated their lives to securing the nation's liberty. The road to independence was paved with revolts, protests, and powerful movements that reflected the unbreakable spirit of Indians. This long struggle finally led to the historic moment in 1947 when Lord Mountbatten, the last British Viceroy, formally declared India free. The essence of Independence Day is captured through the hoisting of the national tricolor, patriotic songs, cultural programs, and parades held throughout the nation. The tradition of flag hoisting at the Red Fort in Delhi began when Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru, India's first Prime Minister, unfurled the flag at the Lahori Gate on the dawn of independence. Since then, this tradition has continued every year, with the Prime Minister addressing the nation after raising the flag.

## **SCOPE OF THE PROGRAM :**

The Independence Day celebration program marks 79 years of India's freedom and provides an opportunity to reflect on the nation's glorious journey from colonial rule to sovereignty. The program highlights the sacrifices and struggles of freedom fighters, honors their legacy, and instills a sense of pride and patriotism among citizens. Through flag hoisting, cultural performances, speeches, and patriotic activities, the event aims to unite people in the spirit of nationalism and remind everyone of the values of freedom, unity, and democracy that form the foundation of our nation.

## **HIGHLIGHTS OF THE DAY :**

The Independence Day celebrations commenced early in the morning at 6:00 AM, with NSS volunteers actively participating in the preparations. A beautiful rangoli was drawn and filled with vibrant colors, while the boys took charge of decorating the quadrangle with tricolour flags and balloons, creating a festive atmosphere. By 7:45 AM, all the arrangements were completed, and the volunteers, along with the teachers, were provided with tricolour badges to mark the occasion.

The formal program began at 8:00 AM with the rendition of the State Anthem, followed by an invocation song. The program was graced by the presence of distinguished dignitaries including Sri V. Rajendra Naidu, Joint Secretary of KS Group of Institutions; Sri M. Yogamurthy, Internal Auditor of KS Group of Institutions; Sri A.V. Following the flag hoisting ceremony, Sri R. Rajagopal Naidu President of KS Group of Institute, and Sri R. Leela Shankar Rao Secretary of KS Group Of Institute delivered inspiring speeches. They highlighted the glory of **Operation Sindoor**, the history of the national flag, and the true spirit of Independence Day.

The cultural segment of the celebration featured a series of patriotic performances. KSIT engineering students presented two patriotic dance performances, one of which was dedicated to the bravery of soldiers who participated in **Operation Sindoor**. Students from KSPUC and KS Degree Block also showcased patriotic dances, paying tribute to the sacrifices of the Indian Armed Forces who safeguard our nation.
