- The training improves the productivity and efficiency of volunteers in various work fields.
- The program promotes continuous learning and adaptability among volunteers.
- The initiative inspires volunteers to think creatively and develop innovative solutions.
- It contributes to national development by creating a skilled and capable volunteer workforce.

SCOPE OF THE PROGRAM :

The skill development program aims to equip volunteers and youth with both technical and soft skills required to meet the demands of modern workplaces. Skill development not only helps in reducing unemployment by making individuals job-ready but also promotes entrepreneurship by enabling volunteers to start their own ventures. It ensures inclusive growth by providing equal training opportunities to women, rural youth, and marginalized communities. Moreover, skill development programs help individuals adapt to rapid technological advancements and global standards, thereby enhancing the overall productivity and competitiveness of the workforce. By fostering continuous learning, upskilling, and reskilling, the scope of skill development contributes significantly to national progress and economic growth.

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE PROGRAM :

A three-day Skill Development Program was conducted from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., organized by Ms. Brundha and Ms. Anusha from **YUVAKA SANGHA**, a Bengaluru-based youth organization founded in 1944. The organization has benefited over 200,000 students by providing quality and affordable education over the years. The main objective of the program was to enhance the personal, social, and professional skills of volunteers through interactive learning. Throughout the three days, our volunteers had the opportunity to evolve themselves, discover their interests, and build confidence through active participation in a variety of activities.

Several sessions were conducted, including interactive sessions, group activities, and communication skill development exercises that helped participants improve their

speaking, listening, and presentation abilities. Volunteers also took part in group decision-making tasks, which enhanced their teamwork, leadership, and problem-solving skills. The self-grading activity, where participants rated their own skills and talents on a scale of five, encouraged self-awareness and reflection on areas of strength and improvement. In addition, the volunteers were introduced to an AI course, providing them with insights into modern digital tools and technologies essential in today's world. As part of the program's outcome, each volunteer received an offer letter to teach AI skills to students in government schools, giving them an opportunity to share knowledge and contribute to society.

A total of 63 students actively participated in the program, making it an engaging and enriching experience for all. The skill development program helped volunteers enhance their communication, leadership, and technological skills while fostering teamwork, confidence and a spirit of community service that will benefit them in their future endeavors.
