OBJECTIVES :

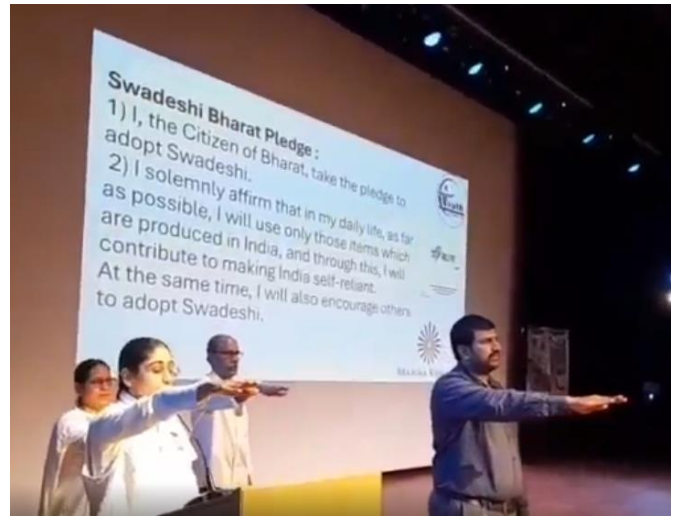
- To educate participants about the harmful effects of drug abuse.
