OBJECTIVES :

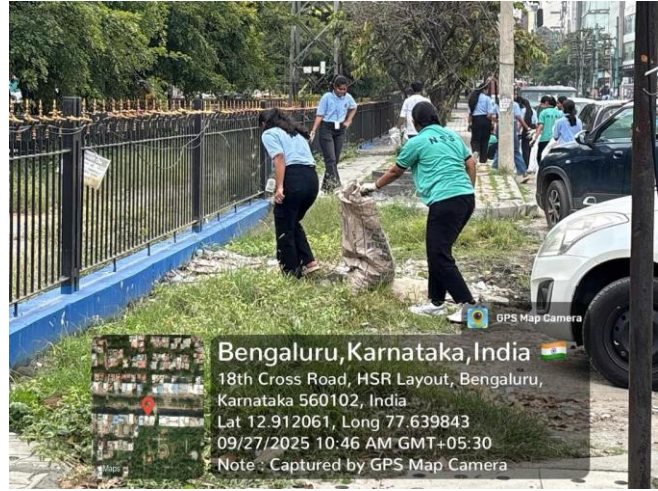
- To create awareness about the importance of cleanliness in public places.
