- To provide immunization and basic diagnostic tests.
- To refer serious cases to hospitals for further treatment.
- To improve overall community health.

SCOPE OF THE PROGRAM :

A health camp provides basic medical services such as general check-ups, blood tests, and eye and dental screening. It creates awareness about hygiene, nutrition, and prevention of common diseases. The camp includes vaccination drives and screening for conditions like diabetes and hypertension. It mainly serves rural and underprivileged communities with limited access to healthcare. It also helps in early diagnosis and referral of serious cases to hospitals. Overall, it improves community health and promotes preventive care.

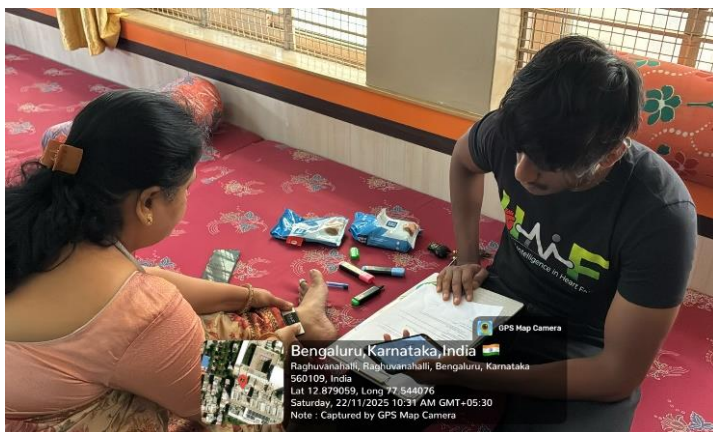
HIGHLIGHTS OF THE DAY :

At 9:00 AM, the doctors from Prabha Eye Clinic and the cardiology team arrived at our college campus. They were warmly welcomed and served breakfast as a token of appreciation. The health camp commenced at 9:30 AM with two separate check-up sites arranged for the convenience of participants. The eye check-up was conducted in a medical van stationed near the PU Block, while the heart check-up was organized in the Old Block, 1st Floor, Room No. 101. The camp was open to both students, teaching and non-teaching staff. A large number of participants registered and actively took part in the health screening.

The eye examination was conducted by specialized doctors and included detailed vision tests and basic eye health evaluation. The heart check-up was carried out using a smart microchip device placed on the ankle of the patient to monitor heart functioning and overall cardiac health. After the screening, the reports were directly sent to the participants' mobile phones for easy access and future reference. The camp witnessed a huge turnout, and all participants greatly

benefited from the medical guidance and reports provided. The initiative helped many individuals understand their current health condition and take necessary preventive measures.

The health camp was successfully conducted with active participation from students and staff. It created awareness about the importance of regular eye and heart check-ups and encouraged everyone to prioritize their health.
