## **HISTORY OF ENVIRONMENT DAY**

Republic Day is celebrated every year on January 26 to mark the day when India's Constitution came into effect in 1950. Although India gained independence on August 15, 1947, it did not have its own permanent constitution and followed laws based on the Government of India Act, 1935. To establish India as a sovereign democratic republic, a Constituent Assembly was formed to draft the Constitution under the leadership of Dr. B. R. Ambedkar. The Constitution was completed and officially adopted on January 26, 1950.

The date January 26 was chosen to honor the declaration of "Purna Swaraj" (complete independence) made in 1930 by the Indian National Congress. Since then, Republic Day has been celebrated with pride across the country, especially in New Delhi, with parades, cultural programs, and patriotic displays. The day reminds citizens of their rights, duties, and the importance of unity, democracy, and justice.

## **SCOPE OF THE PROGRAM**

The scope of the event included organizing patriotic activities such as flag hoisting and singing of the national anthem. It encouraged the active participation of students, faculty members, and NSS volunteers. Cultural programs were conducted to reflect the spirit of unity and diversity of the nation. The event also aimed to spread awareness about national values, responsibilities, and constitutional principles among all participants.

## **HIGHLIGHTS OF THE EVENT**

On 26th January 2026, Republic Day was celebrated with great enthusiasm in our college, K. S. Institute of Technology, at the quadrangle of the old building.
