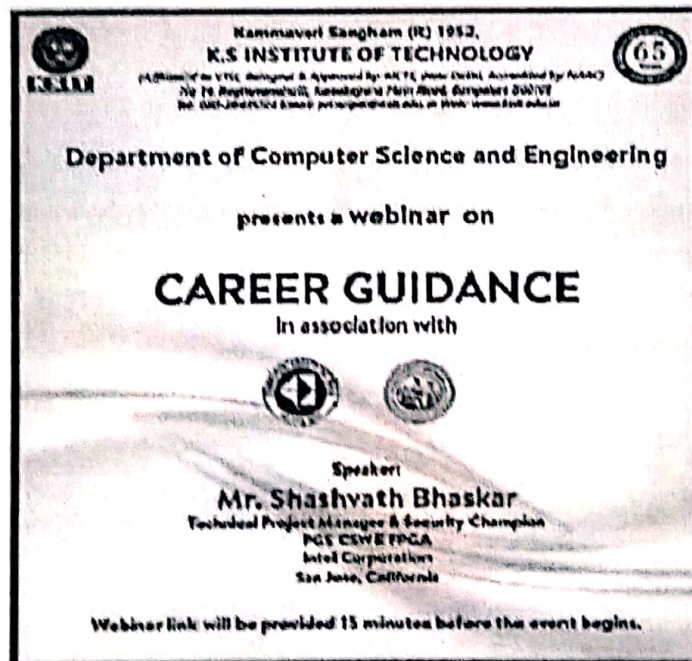




Fig. 1 Seminar on "Career Guidance"

- ❖ Obtain resume building assistance from real people, offered by LinkedIn to build an excellent resume
- ❖ Make an adaptable resume to change according to the job applying
- ❖ Reach out to seniors from different companies for referrals and guidance
- ❖ Build connections and networks using LinkedIn with various managers and employees at different companies

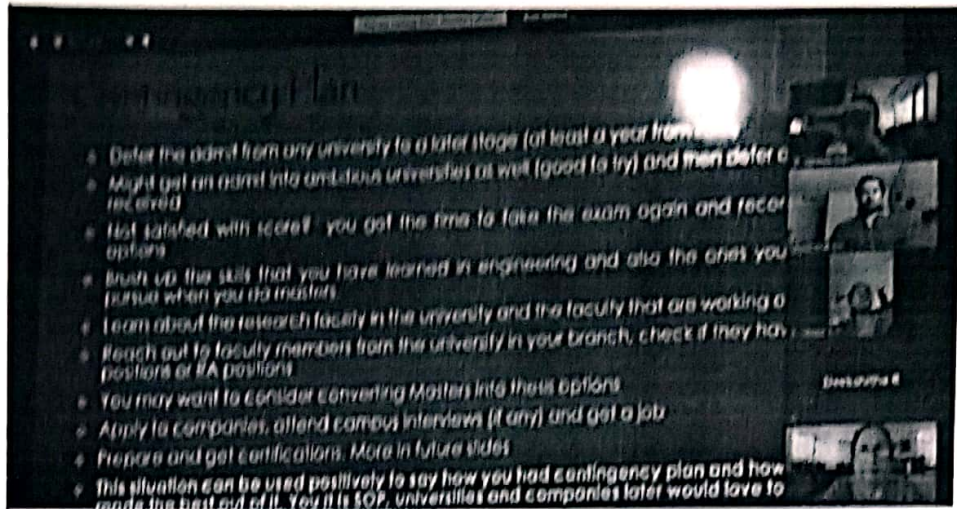


Fig. 6: Webinar Online Session

He mainly focused on the following aspects:

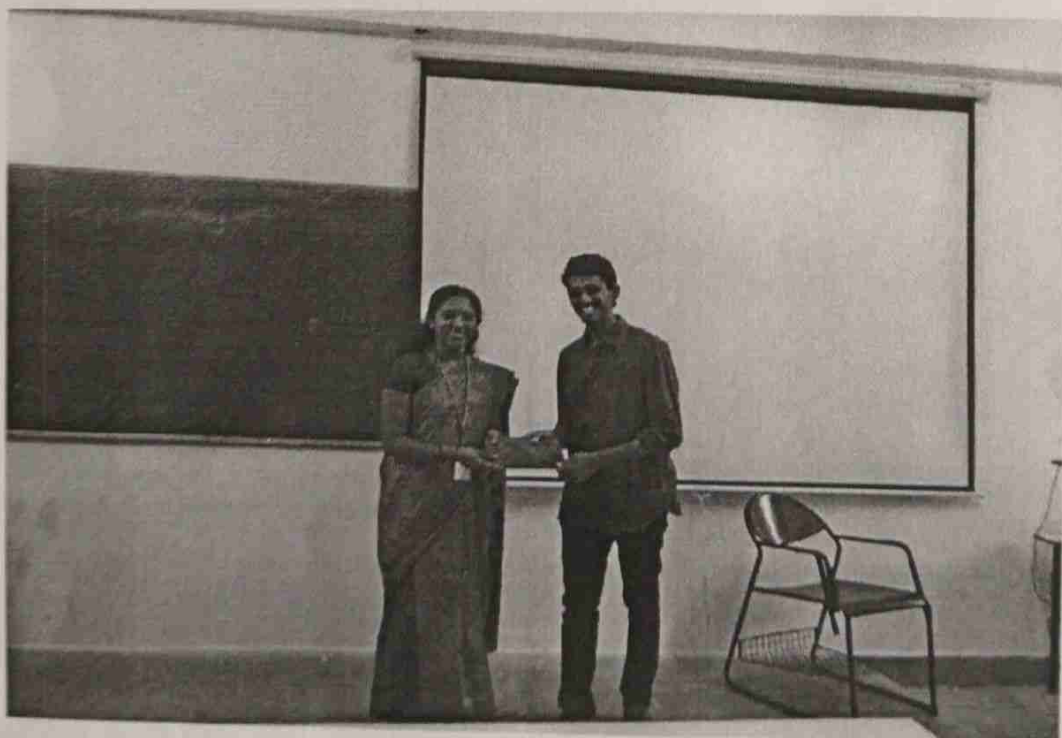

It also motivated students to learn new technologies and programming languages. The Talk ended with vote of thanks. All the students liked the session very much and are looking forward to many more like this.





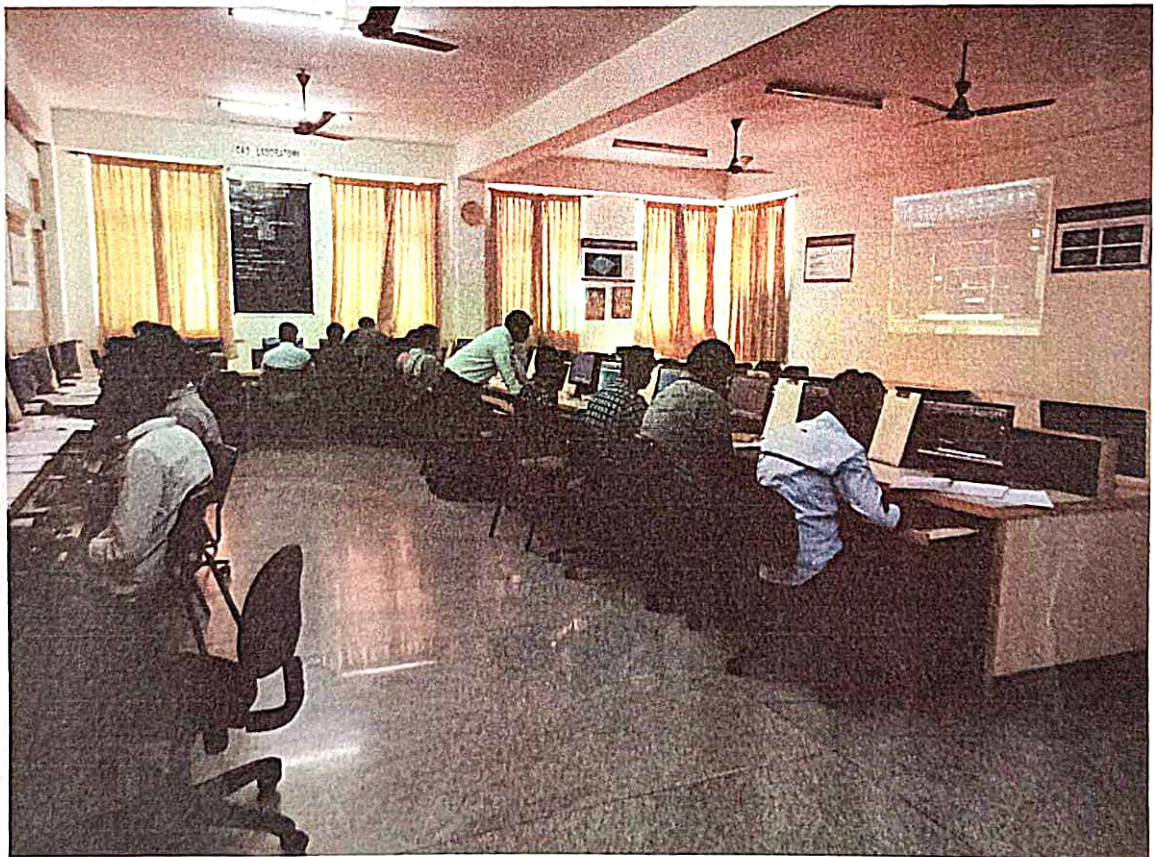
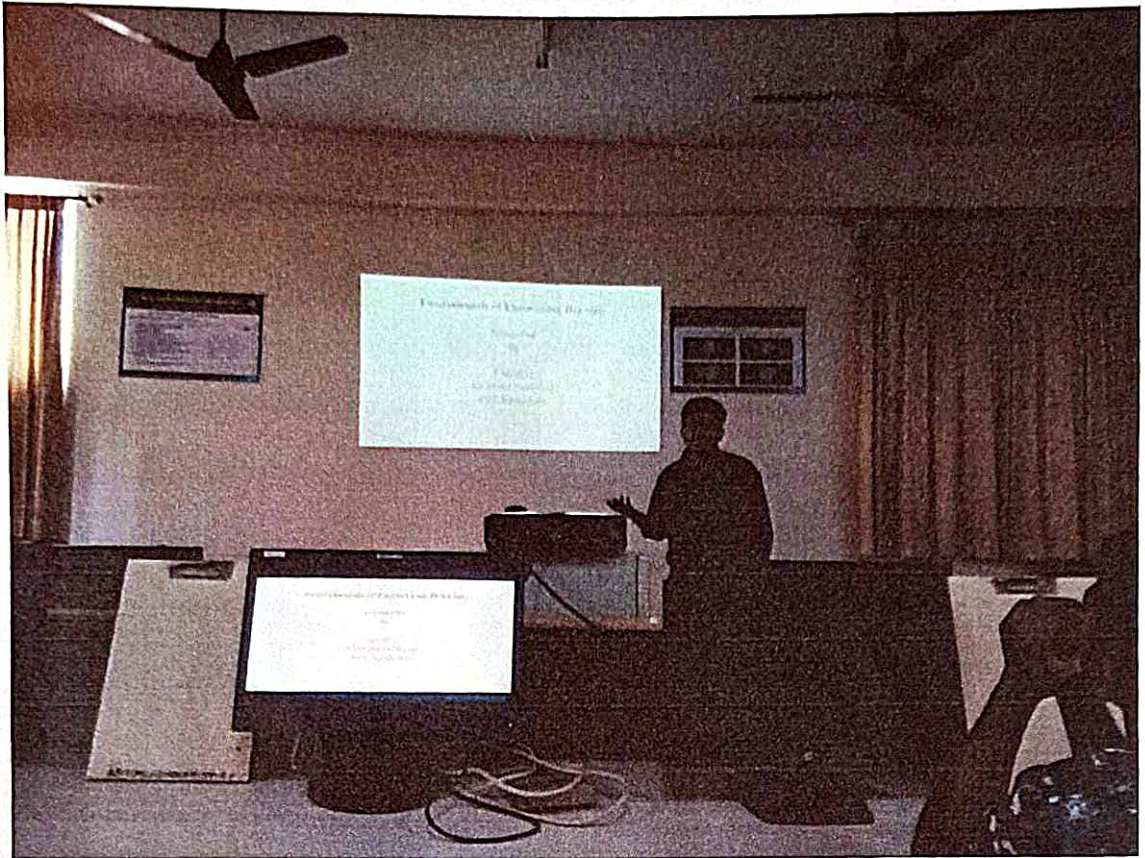
3. About AUTOCAD


