


Fig. 1 Seminar on "Career Guidance






Fig. 2 Speaker's Introduction




Fig 3: Details on pursuing Masters




Fig. 6: Webinar Online Session






Report on



He mainly focused on the following aspects:




4. Analysis and evaluation of the Workshop
