

NSS Day Wise Detailed Narrative Report, Scanned Copies of the News Paper Reports and Action Photos

DAY 1:



All the NSS students gathered at KS Institute of Technology campus around 09:00 a.m. and the bus departed by 09:30 a.m. We reached Grama Swarajya high school, Aiyonnora Gollahalli, Kanakapura taluk, Ramanagar district around 11:20 a.m. We placed all our luggage in the hostel of Grama Swarajya school where we stayed for one week. Later we started cleaning the school premises. We had our lunch around 02:30 p.m. and then assembled for day meet up where all of us were divided into 5 teams, KRANTIVEERA SANGOLLI RAYYANNA, VISHVESWSARAYA, KITTURU RANI CHENNAMMA, KUVEMPU, SWAMI VIVEKANANDA, each team consisting of 10 to 11 MEMBERS.

The Captains for the camp were Vishal and Vaishnavi Shriharshan followed by Amogh and Naganethra as Vice Captains. The Captain and Vice Captain for Swami Vivekananda team were Vaishnavi S. and Sumukha and this team was given with cooking incharge. The Captain and Vice Captain of Vishweshwaraiah team were Ganesh and Darshanand the team was given with incharge of flag hoisting for the next day. The Captain and Vice


DAY 5:



HISTORY OF CONSTITUTION DAY

Constitution Day also known as "National Law Day", is celebrated in India on 26 November every year to commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India. On 26 November 1949, the Constituent Assembly of India adopted to the Constitution of India, and it came into effect on

26 January 1950. The Prime Minister of India Narendra Modi made the declaration on 11 October 2015 while laying the foundation stone of the B. R. Ambedkar's Statue of Equality memorial in Mumbai. The year of 2021 was the 131th birth anniversary of Ambedkar, who had chaired the drafting committee of the Constituent Assembly and played a pivotal role in the drafting of the constitution. Previously this day was celebrated as Law Day. 26 November was chosen to spread the importance of the constitution and to spread thoughts and ideas of Ambedkar.
