OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAM

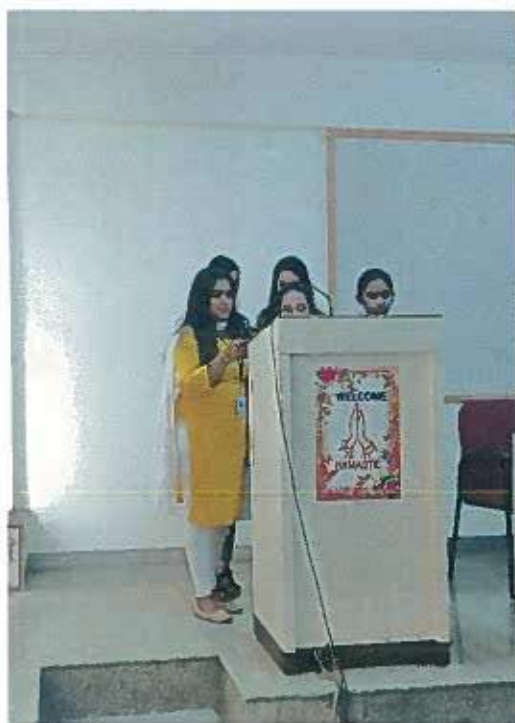

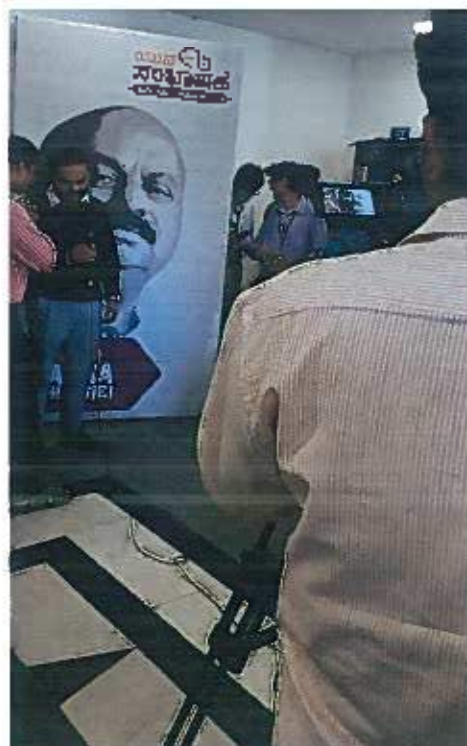
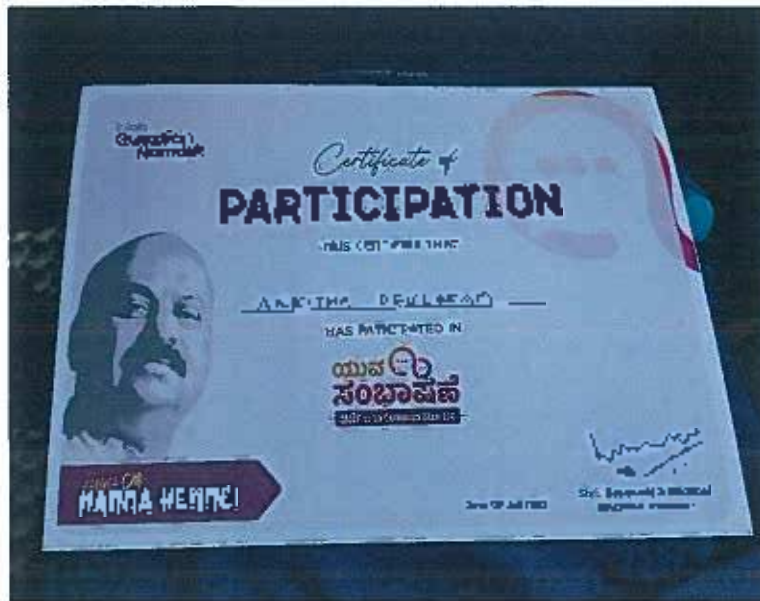
OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAM


